How to Use One 'N Only

One 'N Only is formulated as a complete feed. No additional hay, grain mix or supplements are required. It is designed to be used free choice, so just one feeding a day is necessary.

1. Getting Started with One 'N Only As a Free Choice Feed

Changes in feeding programs should be made gradually over a period of 5 to 6 days. During the change, blend One 'N Only with your current ration, increasing One 'N Only at the rate of 3 to 4 lbs per head per day. Reduce the amount of grain first, then start to remove hay. Once horses are adapted to feeding One 'N Only, usually when a 100lb horse is eating 20lbs, you can now begin to fill self feeders and give your horse full access to One 'N Only. Horse's intake will vary with requirements but will average in the 20 to 22lb range. Daily consumption will vary, so it is important to keep feed available to horses at all times.

2. The One 'N Only Maintenance Program

Once acclimated, all you have to do is keep One 'N Only available. You can feed once per day or whatever your schedule permits. Just use the 2% of body weight rule, and your horse and One 'N Only will take care of the rest!

3. One 'N Only as a Hay Extender

One 'N Only is the hay substitute for all or part of your horse's daily hay ration. It is ideal for horses at risk from founder, and Cushing's Syndrome as it is extremely low in soluble starch and sugar. When using One 'N Only as a forage source, simply replace every lb of hay you would normally feed 3/4 lbs of One 'N Only. As there is no waste with One 'N Only as compared to normal hay, you can feed less. As an example, if you normally feed 15lbs of normal hay, you only need to feed about 11 lbs of One 'N Only.
