### ***INGREDIENTS:***

Grain products, plant protein products, processed grain by-products, dehydrated alfalfa meal, cane molasses, dicalcium phosphate, slat, calcium carbonate, dl-methionine, l-lysine, vitamin A supplement, vitamin D3 supplement, vitamin E supplement, choline chloride, vitamin B12 supplement, riboflavin supplement, niacinamide, d-calcium pantothenate, menadione sodium bisulfate complex, thiamine mononitrate, d-biotin, folic acid, pyridoxine hydrochloride, potassium sulfate, magnesium sulfate, manganous oxide, zinc oxide, ferrous sulfate, copper sulfate, ethylenediamine dihydriodide, sodium selenite and artificial flavor.

### ***FEEDING DIRECTIONS:***

**NURSING FOALS:** This feed is designed to be fed at a rate of 1.0 to 2.0 lbs per 100 lbs of body weight daily. It may be creep-fed.

**EARLY WEANED FOALS:** Should be fed at a rate of 1.5 to 3.0 lbs. per 100 lbs of body weight daily. Also introduce hay or equivalent pasture at the rate of ½ to 1 lb per 100 lbs of body weight.

**WEANLINGS:** Feed at a rate of 1.5 to 3.0 lbs. per 100 lbs of body weight daily. Offer hay or equivalent pasture at a rate of 1.0 to 1.5 lbs per 100 lbs of body weight daily.

**MARES:** For early lactation feed 1.0 to 2.0 lbs per 100 lbs of body weight daily and offer hay or equivalent pasture at a rate of 1.0 to 2.0 lbs per 100 lbs of body weight.
