# WENDLAND'S 37% RANGE BLOCKS

Feed to: Ruminants only; cows, heifers, ewes, nannies

### What is it?

- A high protein block- 37% crude protein
- 50% of protein equivalent from NPN (urea)
- Fortified with vitamins and minerals
- Highly palatable

### **Suggested Usage:**

- When forage is low in protein but forage availability is high
- Protein supplementation may increase forage consumption by 20 to 40%
- When the convenience of self feeding is important

Form: A 33.3 lb. pressed block, medium hard

### **Feeding Directions:**

- Since this product contains non-protein nitrogen, introduce it slowly to the herd initially by feeding limited amounts for the first few days, then gradually increasing to free choice.
- After the first few days of free choice feeding, consumption should level off to 1.0 to 2.0 lbs daily for cows and <sup>1</sup>/<sub>4</sub> to <sup>1</sup>/<sub>2</sub> lb daily for sheep and goats.
- If consumption does not decrease to desired levels
- Supply 25 blocks per 100 head of cattle or 5 blocks per 100 sheep
- Be sure livestock have an adequate supply of pasture or roughage (at least 1.5% of body weight daily) and water.
