**FEEDING DIRECTIONS**

**FOR ADULT DOGS:** Feed Wendland's Chunk Style Dog Food straight from the bag or moisten with water, milk, broth or gravy. If moist feeding is desired, mix no more than 6 parts food to 1 part liquid.

A dog should be maintained in good body condition and not allowed to become overweight. The food intake required to maintain good body condition will vary depending on age, activity level, environment and other stress factors. Consequently, the food requirement for each dog will vary, and should be adjusted accordingly. Use the standard chart below as a guide. Pregnant, nursing and hardworking dogs or dogs exposed to cold weather may required 2-3 times these amounts.

When high activity or other factors require high feed intake, twice a day feeding is recommended. However, for most normally active dogs over one year old, once a day feeding is usually sufficient.

**FOR PUPPIES:** Puppies begin to eat solid food at 3-4 weeks of age. Add warm water to soften the food and, 8 weeks, mix water or feed dry. Feed pups all the moistened Wendland's they will consume at intervals throughout the day, or use the chart as a guide and feed approximately twice as much as suggested. After one year, follow adult feeding instructions. If fed dry, food may be kept before the pups at all times.
